As a property owner, tenant, or person who has requested notice, please be advised that the Contra Costa Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and is considering an application to modify the solid waste facility permit (SWFP) for the Keller Canyon Landfill. The LEA is certified by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County of Contra Costa, including all active and closed landfills.

Description of Project and LEA's Preliminary Determination

Keller Canyon Landfill is an approximately 1399 acre existing landfill with a permitted disposal area of 244 acres. The landfill is located at 901 Bailey Road, Pittsburg, California, in the unincorporated area of Contra Costa County. On December 23, 2008, the LEA accepted for review the SWFP application package from Keller Canyon Landfill Company requesting a modification to clarify the maximum waste tonnages per day and to define the waste types as they have been received at the facility. No other changes are under consideration at this time.

The LEA finds that the proposed change is a non-material change pursuant to Title 27 §21665 and qualifies as a permit modification. The LEA's preliminary determination is that the proposed permit modification be approved.

The decision to issue or not to issue the SWFP (revision, Modified, new) must be made by the LEA within 120 days of the date the application was deemed complete as required by Statute. Prior to issuance of the SWFP, the LEA must request and receive concurrence from the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB).
