Public health investigation reveals all patients with severe symptoms attended a free concert Monday evening at the Dean Leshner Regional Center for the Arts. Eight patients admitted with severe symptoms, two of whom are employed as cleaning crew at the Leshner Center. State Lab analysis confirms Yersinia pestis bacteria from canisters that were spraying into HVAC intake. Hospitals, clinics and EMS providers are being notified of a Declared Public Health Emergency.
