



## Recommended Provisions for a Model Secondhand Smoke Policy

Compiled by the Public Health Division, Contra Costa Health Services, May 2006

### Smoking to be prohibited:

- **In any indoor workplace** (add to definition of workplaces to include all entities formed for profit-making & to definition of employee to include volunteers.)  
*CA Jurisdiction with Similar Law\**: Dublin defined tobacco shops and smokers lounge as workplaces. Pleasant Hill includes tobacco shop as a workplace.
- **Within 20 feet of the doors, operable windows, air ducts and ventilation systems of any worksite** covered by LC6404.5 and local clean air ordinances.  
*CA Jurisdiction with Similar Law\**: San Ramon (50 feet), Berkeley, Davis, Stockton & Santa Barbara (20 feet); Oakland (25 feet); Dublin and Alameda County (15 feet). County of San Mateo, county buildings only (30 ft from building. No smoking within 20 feet of doorways currently for all public buildings under state law.
- **In outdoor dining areas** (including private dining areas such as employee courtyards).  
*CA Jurisdiction with Similar Law\**: San Ramon, Berkeley, Davis, Alameda County, Newark, Pleasanton, Union City, Dublin (includes private dining areas such as employee court yards.)
- **On public trails.** *CA Jurisdiction with Similar Law\**: San Ramon, Livermore Area Recreation and Parks District.
- **In public parks.** *CA Jurisdiction with Similar Law\**: Capitola, Laguna Beach (beaches); Fresno, San Francisco (parks and all areas open to the public except for the golf course), Ventura (parks, beaches).
- **In service areas.** Service area defined as an area used to receive or wait for a service, enter a public place or make a transaction, including ATM's, bank teller windows, ticket lines, bus stops and taxi stands.  
*CA Jurisdiction with Similar Law\**: Davis, City of San Mateo, Berkeley, Dublin and San Francisco (bus stops); service lines in Dublin, Fremont, Hayward, Livermore, Newark, Pleasanton and Union City. Garages in Berkeley.
- **In public event venues** (stadiums, fairs, pavilions) *CA Jurisdiction with Similar Law\**: Arcata (plaza); Davis, Redlands ("Market Night"); City of San Mateo (performance venues); Stadiums in Livermore, Newark and Pleasanton.
- **In common indoor or outdoor areas** of multi-unit housing of 4 or more units.  
*CA Jurisdiction with Similar Law\**: *Indoor Common Areas*: 70+ communities inc. Alameda County, Berkeley, Dublin, Fremont, Hayward, Livermore, Newark, Oakland, Pleasanton, Union City, Butte County, Davis, Fremont. *Outdoor & Indoor Common Areas*: County of San Mateo, Arcata, Chico, Davis, Healdsburg, Laguna Woods.
