

Now that you're pregnant . . . what about health care?



You may be eligible for a special Medi-Cal program called Presumptive Eligibility (PE)

What is Presumptive Eligibility (PE)?

A Medi-Cal program providing immediate, temporary health coverage for low-income pregnant women.

Who is eligible for PE?

You are, if you are pregnant and your family income is under a certain amount. Also, you need to receive health care through a participating Medi-Cal provider. Ask your provider if they offer this coverage and how to apply.

What services does PE cover?

All walk-in prenatal care services are covered.

Delivery and family planning services are covered by other programs. Call for more information.

Will PE pay for the pregnancy test?

Yes, if you are eligible it will pay for a pregnancy test done at a health center that accepts Medi-Cal.

Do I still apply for Medi-Cal ?

Yes, PE will cover you while the County Welfare Department is processing your Medi-Cal or CalWorks application.

I am an immigrant. Can I get PE?

Yes, PE is available regardless of immigrant status.
