

## Quality Programs

The state licensed DUI programs in Contra Costa County provide the education and counseling services that DUI offenders must satisfactorily receive in order to satisfy their conditions of probation and to fully restore their California driver licenses.

The DUI programs operate according to Title 9 of the California Code of Regulations and other portions of California law. These programs are monitored by the county and by the state.

Participants pay for the program services that they receive. Extended payment plans may be available, and participants who are receiving general assistance can receive full services for \$5 per month.

## Licensed DUI Programs



**DUI Programs are located in eastern, central and western Contra Costa County**

Each licensed DUI program in the county provides the following DUI-related programs:

- Wet and Reckless
- 3-month first offender (BAC below 0.15%)
- 6-month first offender (BAC = 0.15—0.19%)
- 9-month first offender (BAC = 0.2% and above)
- 18-month multiple offender

A court-ordered assessment that is not done by a DUI program will be used to independently determine if the court should order additional services.

When you call the program the receptionist will make an appointment for you and will tell you what papers to bring and how much your down payment will be. Tell the receptionist if you expect to have trouble making payments, and the receptionist will tell you the program's procedure for making fee adjustments. **DO NOT FAIL TO COME TO THE APPOINTMENT.**
