DUI Program Completions & Transfers

Summary

The Contra Costa County-operated DUI programs closed on June 30, 2004. Private providers, located across the county now provide the full range of DUI program services.

Current regulations require most participants who have been absent from the program more than two years to start the program over.



Former participants in the county-operated program who wish to confirm that they completed may be able to do so if they completed no more than four years ago.

We destroy DUI records after 4 years

Criminal Justice Services (CJS) East and CJS Central closed for good on June 30, 2004. CJS West closed 6 months before that. The records for those programs are only retained for 4 years and then they are destroyed. There are no records remaining for participants who completed the program before February 2003. Therefore, the County cannot verify DUI program completion from before that time.



Don't put it off any longer

Because of regulatory requirements and the time that has passed since the County closed its DUI

programs, very few former participants will qualify to receive credit for their earlier participation.

Excellent fully licensed DUI programs exist throughout the County to serve you now.

Verifying that you completed a county-operated DUI Program

When you completed our DUI program you were given the original DL 101 Completion Certificate to deliver to DMV. Since then County and DMV procedures have changed and you will not be able to hand-deliver a proof of completion. If you failed to turn in your Certificate of Completion, or if there has been some other problem, we will try to help you verify to DMV that you did complete. However, the more time has passed since you completed, the more difficult it is for us to verify that you did complete one of our DUI programs.

If the County still has your program record and the record shows that you did graduate, then the County DUI Program Coordinator will verify your completion to DMV by sending a letter internally to the proper office within DMV. When DMV receives the letter it will be put in line with the other requests that DMV is processing. Therefore, it may take anywhere from a few days to several weeks before DMV is able to update your records in their computer. **You will not speed up the process by calling or visiting DMV.**

Transferring to Another DUI Program from a Former County-Operated DUI Program

California Code of Regulations, § 9886 (f), which became effective August 30, 2002, requires participants who have been out of the program for two years or more to start the program over. Therefore, a former participant in a county-operated DUI program who wants to satisfy DMV requirements should start over in one of the licensed DUI programs listed here.
